

# CAMPING TERMS & CONDITIONS 2020

The purchase and use of the campsite and facilities is subject to and conditional upon the following Terms and Conditions:

## 1. ACCEPTANCE OF CONDITIONS

The Event organiser is Active Sport & Entertainment Limited (t/a Active Sport), Company Number 10225082 whose registered address is at Tintagel House, 92 Albert Embankment, LONDON, SE1 7TY ("**Organiser**").

The persons purchasing camping shall be deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions and to have entered into a legally binding contract with the Organiser when they (a) accept the terms and conditions of purchase by clicking the relevant field in the online purchase option and (b) pay the appropriate purchase fee (if applicable).

The following Terms and Conditions relate to the temporary campsite located at Hylands Park ("**Campsite**"), which will be installed as part of the Vélo Essex Event ("**Event**"), organised by Active Sport.

## 2. CONDITIONS OF CAMPING

2.1 Only people having properly registered and purchased camping in accordance with these Terms and Conditions are eligible to have use of the Campsite and facilities that are associated to the Event. ("**Camper(s)**").

2.2 By booking camping as detailed on the Organiser's [website](#), using the online entry system, Campers are agreeing to abide by these Terms & Conditions.

2.3 It is the responsibility of the person making the booking for camping to ensure that all members of their party are aware of and agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.

## 3. CONFIRMATION OF CAMPING BOOKING

Completion of a transaction through the online payment system confirms the Camper's place on the Campsite and an automated confirmation email will be received. This confirmation email will be required to be shown on arrival at the Campsite.

## 4. CAMPING INFORMATION

All necessary information pertaining to camping at the Event will be available on the Organiser's [website](#). You will not receive anything in hard copy format, however, the Organiser will provide regular newsletters about the Event and camping when new information is available. It is the responsibility of the Camper to ensure they have accessed the relevant information.

## 5. CANCELLATION OR ALTERATION OF CAMPING

The Camper acknowledges and accepts that circumstances concerning the Event and/or Campsite may change from time to time for reasons outside of the Organiser's reasonable control or otherwise, without the Organiser incurring any liability and without any rights being accrued by the Camper(s) save as expressly set out in these Terms and Conditions.

5.1 The Organiser may cancel the Event and/or Campsite because of circumstances beyond the reasonable control of the Organiser including, without limitation, war, civil or political unrest, transport disruptions, terrorism, including reasonable threat thereof, inclement weather conditions, death of a member of the royal family, and any legislation, regulations, ruling or omission of any relevant government, court, competent national authority or governing body, on advice of any security or police force and/or local authority consent or approval, or withdrawal of such consent or approval, ("**Force Majeure**"). In such circumstances, the Camper(s) will not be entitled to any refund, including any processing/booking/administration fees and/or compensation of other losses, such as travelling or accommodation expenses.

5.2 The Organiser reserves the right to cancel the Event and/or Campsite for any reason, but where such reason is not attributable to Force Majeure, the Camper(s) will be entitled to a refund of their fees (but excluding any processing/booking/administration fees).

- 5.3 Camper(s) may cancel their booking for the Campsite at any time by contacting [hello@veloessex.com](mailto:hello@veloessex.com). No refunds will be payable in the event of a cancellation by the Camper(s) at any time.
- 5.4 The Organiser reserves the right to change the date of the Event. In the event of such change of date, and if the Camper(s) is unable to attend on the revised date, they have 7 days to inform the Organiser in writing from when the change in date is announced to receive a refund of their camping fees paid (excluding any processing/booking/administration fees).

## **6 LIABILITY AND INSURANCE**

- 6.1 The use of the Campsite and facilities is at each Camper's own risk. The Camper irrevocably agrees to hold harmless, indemnify and reimburse the Organiser from and for any liability, sum, costs, damages or expenses (including legal and professional fees) incurred by the Organiser in connection with any accident, loss, damage or injury (including death) arising out of the Camper's attendance and use of the Campsite and facilities or any part thereof in connection with the Event and/or Campsite (except where any such injury or death is caused by the negligence of the Organiser or any of its employees).
- 6.2 Under no circumstances shall the Organiser be liable to the Camper(s) in contract, tort (including negligence) or otherwise for any loss of business, revenue or profits, charity funds, anticipated savings or wasted expenditure, or any indirect or consequential loss or damage whatsoever (notwithstanding that such loss was within the contemplation of the parties at the date of submitting the Camping Entry Form) arising out of the Camper(s) using the Campsite and associated facilities or any other matter arising under these Terms and Conditions nor for an aggregate amount greater than the Camping Fee (excluding any processing/booking/administration fees) paid by the Camper.

## **7. RIGHT OF REFUSAL FOR ENTRY**

Should Campers breach the Campsite Rules & Obligations, the Organiser reserves the right to (a) refuse or revoke a booking to any Camper(s), (b) disqualify Camper(s) from the Event, and (c) exclude the Camper(s) from participation in future events organised by the Organiser.

## **8. CAMPSITE RULES & OBLIGATIONS**

The Campsite will have security throughout the event weekend. The following rules will be in place across the whole of the event weekend to ensure the safety of all campers:

- The speed limit within the Campsite is 5mph
- No BBQ's
- Any gas cookers must be elevated off the ground
- No fires/fireworks/chinese lanterns on site
- Generators are not permitted
- No glass of any kind is allowed in the camp site
- No sleeping in cars overnight
- Only one vehicle per pitch (any additional vehicles need to be paid for and parked in the camp site car park)
- No sound systems allowed – Please be considerate. If you are deemed to be making too much noise you will be asked politely to lower the volume to a considerate level. Failure to do so will result in you being removed from the site
- Please ensure that any rubbish you create is put in the bins provided – do not leave rubbish behind
- Children must be supervised at all times
- No pets allowed within the camp site
